I seek from this Tribunal that it orders the following: That:

21st February 2004

- 1. I am left in peace to live in my own house,
- 2. I can live without any harassment or stalking from any of my three daughters,
- 3. I can have Trevor live with me,
- 4. I am very happy living in my own house,
- 5. I am left to manage my own business affairs myself,
- 6. I can manage everything myself including washing, dressing, cooking and most household chores,
- 7. Cheryl returns my red Toyota car including the GPS Navman navigator,
- 8. Faye returns all my private and personal papers and those of my husband Harry, including my marriage certificate of 55 years duration, both our full birth certificates and all the German hand written letters to Harry's mother which came to Harry after his mother's death and my note and coin collection,
- 9. Faye, Cheryl and Leonie pay the costs incurred for preparing for this hearing

Reasons why the Tribunal should grant the above:

- o Harry's will specifically left everything to Lynette,
- Lynette is capable of making her own decisions and likes Trevor living with her,
- The Psychologist's report is clear on this subject and the evidence in it is insurmountable.
- The Enduring Power of Attorney has not been activated as Trevor is of the opinion that Nette is capable of managing her own affairs and as such has not filed it with the bank.
